ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

D&A Decorations Ltd. recognises that it has a responsibility to the environment beyond legal and regulatory requirements. We are committed to reducing our environmental impact and continually improving our environmental performance as an integral part of our business strategy and operating methods, with regular review points. We will encourage customers, suppliers and other stakeholders to do the same.

We endeavour to:

- 1) Comply with all relevant regulatory requirements.
- 2) Continually improve and reduce environmental impacts.
- 3) Incorporate environmental factors into business decisions.
- 4) Conserve the use of resources, particularly those which are scarce or non-renewable, by:
 - Avoiding waste and encouraging conservation, re-use and recycling.
 - Preserving, restoring and enhancing the built and natural heritage
 - Encouraging the sustainable use of land-based resources.
 - Reducing air, land and water pollution.
- 5) Increase employee awareness and training.

The company commits to:

- 1) Workforce: It is our intention to minimise travel distances by using labour that resides close to the job.
- 2) Transport & Delivery of materials: We use a supply chain of national suppliers that cover the whole of the UK with distribution outlets in most towns and cities. Our objective is to bulk buy for site so as to reduce the amount of deliveries required and in turn our suppliers carbon foot print.
- 3) Waste Management & Recycling: We have arrangements with Crown Paints, Dulux (Akzo) and Brewers Decorating Merchants to collect all empty paint containers from site and to take back for recycling. As far as possible this will always coincide with a delivery to further reduce our carbon footprint. Duty of care waste and transfer note will be issued with all collections.
- 4) Environment: It is our aim to install an Envirowash system to all large projects. This will allow us to recycle the water used to wash out brushes/rollers eliminating possible soil contamination and contamination to water courses. All solids and by products produced are classed as eco-friendly waste which is returned to our suppliers for recycling.
- 5) The Future: We will endeavour to keep up with all new changes to legislation and to share our knowledge and expertise with the development of new products generally used within our industry and to offer wherever possible similar and equal approved materials that have a lower environmental impact.
